Book your next tee time online easily with these simple instructions


1. At the online booking screen, click *Members Enter Here* button



- 2. Next enter your username and password and click **Sign-In**. **NOTE:** Your username will start with CMGO followed by 4 numbers, this can be found on your receipt or by calling the clubhouse. The default password is *golf*.
- 3. Now select the date for your next round. **NOTE:** you can only select up to two days in advance for tee times.



4. Please choose to play either 9 or 18 holes. **NOTE**: by default 18 holes is selected for you.




5. Select the time you wish to play from the options presented to you on the screen. **NOTE:** you will notice that tee times indicate how many players are able to play at that time.



6. Choose walking or cart (riding) from the available options, then click **Next**. **NOTE:** you will have the option to individually select walking or riding on the following screen.



7. Your name will be automatically filled in the first player field, If you are playing with other members select the unfilled field and choose **Add Playing Partner** in the list.




8. Use the search field to type in the last name of the member you are adding and then click **Search Club Members** to be presented with a list of members associated with the last name you have entered.



9. Now select the member you wish to add and click **SAVE**. Once you have completed adding your playing partners click the **Book Time** button and you are done. If you have an email associated with your account you will receive an email confirmation with the details of the tee time.



10. If you are playing with a non-member you can add names in place of the guest selection or simply add guest and we will update at tee time check-in.



NOTE: Tee times can be edited or deleted online up to two hours before the tee time. Otherwise please call the pro shop at 858-8909.
